## Minutes

## 1. Discussion

- a. Senior Park
  - i. Approximately \$1600 remaining on grant. Funds need to be spent by September 2017
  - ii. Ideas for park?

We discussed several possible ways to spend remaining balance:

- Crushed gravel pathway
- \* Pet waste station (one or two)
- Bird houses
- \* Butterfly houses (estimated cost \$45-\$50/ea)
- Update senior park sign (with either plants near base or freshen paint on sign)
- Recycled park benches from ACUA (\$300-\$865/ea)
- \* Rhododendrons or Forsythia or Azaleas and/or butterfly weeds (near senior sign)
- Signs with plant descriptions (either where plants are or on the back of the senior park sign).

Ideas with \* were preferred ideas from brainstorming.

If we plant, we need to plant between now and May 25<sup>th</sup> (our next in-person meeting).

Planting advice: buy 1 bag of mulch per plant that we plant (e.g., for Rhododendrons).

We decided that we would plant butterfly weeds and Rhododendrons at our next meeting (May 25<sup>th</sup>).

- iii. Re-engage with Dr. Horner's students.
  - Dr. Horner had a commitment with former student and was not able to attend meeting
- b. Heritage Park
  - i. Initial discussion on design for fall 2017 planting.
    - This is a high profile site so the group recognized that the margin for error is very small. The group discussed starting project at a small scale to keep things manageable (e.g., 1/3 or less the original scale). Build out in phases as time and money permit. The group acknowledged that the benefit of full build out was that it was effective at reducing geese; these same benefits may not extend to smaller scale efforts. Brad is going to

reach out to Al to see if Al is on board with re-starting this project.

- c. Greenfest 2017
  - i. Mike to discuss details and logistics.
    - Discussed circulating a google doc so that members could volunteer for time slots. Set up is scheduled for Friday May 12<sup>th</sup> 4pm-7pm; the main event is Saturday May 13<sup>th</sup> 10am-3pm with a rain date of Sunday May 14<sup>th</sup>.
